SCC Concerns (Rebecca)

-Angela Rogers (SCC president at SHHS) and police chief are looking into the four-way stop and thinking about doing a traffic study. Dave asked if the city plans to communicate the results of the study with the school and district.

-We are encouraged to come in/exit by Stokes and limit traffic through the four-way stop. Some parents and high school drivers drive through the tennis courts. We discussed various drop off/pick up options.

-Dave is thinking about having Ann Anderson come down from the district. He did ask Ann A. about the possibility of a crossing guard, and she would like to wait to hear back from the city. Wendy asked who pays for a crossing guard, and Dave said that the district pays when it is needed.

-Dave will follow up with the district and report back at our next meeting.

Counseling Department Objectives (Cameo)

-Cameo explained the counselor's role in the school and told us that the counselors are reviewed by the state and the district. She explained the review process. The counseling curriculum is based on a needs assessment (the top four needs) and what the teachers don't already teach in their classes.

-Melanie asked how the feeder elementary alignment works. The process begins with 6<sup>th</sup> grade day.

-Cameo presented the 2016 needs assessments results, discussed PBIS lessons, and reviewed the data project, which is about credit recovery and dropout prevention,

-Melanie asked what our biggest issue is, and Cameo reported that it is student anxiety.

-Wendy would like to see some of this counselor information given to the parents. Cameo would like to revamp Hope Week and teach more through advisory.
