Report on Governor's Letter and Cell Phone Use in School

Letter and school policy were reviewed. James notes that there is sufficient data to support the Governor's proposal of limiting phones in classrooms. LaVera shares support for the school's current implementation of the district policy, sharing support for the oversight that teachers currently have in the classroom. Melissa is in favor of classroom bans of phones, also noting that the Governor's letter suggested efforts to educate parents of the data regarding student distraction from phones at school.

School Improvement Plan Proposal

Last year science improved close to ten percent on end of level tests. English and Math had a slight increase in student scores. School's improvement goal is proposed to remain the same focus, to increase student scores on the end of level tests. An overview of the past spending and rules for no more than 10% carryover was reviewed. Expenditures of professional development and some salary costs will be considered as well as the cost for updating Chromebooks. James notes that the proposed plan looks like it is meeting the requisites for the goal.

Vote is taken to approve the proposed plan. The vote is unanimous in favor of approving the plan.
