Rise is for 8th grade, ACT aspire is 9th grade. In ACT aspire English is 3% above district 2 years ago and improved 1 year ago and we were 4% above district. Math 2 years ago we were 4% above district and improved 1 year ago and were 1% above district. Rise math was lower than district and state. Kids do not try as much on Rise so we have been discussing ways to motivate kids. Suggestions: Communication with parents, parents receiving scores.
