Student Attendance Policy

- “If you feel sick, stay home.” Students who are sick or experiencing any symptoms of COVID 19 must stay home. Check <http://sajhs.nebo.edu/> under “COVID Communications” for more information.
- Parents should check for elevated temperatures each morning.
- Teachers will work with students who need to stay home and help with catching up when they return to school. This could occur after school during early out. Teachers may also make material available on Canvas/Google Classroom.

Sanitation — Custodial

- High touch areas (e.g. door handles) will be disinfected several times each day.
- Bathrooms will be sanitized multiple times each day.
- Cleaning of the entire school will take place each evening.

Sanitation — Teachers & Students

- Teachers or students will disinfect desks and any other used surfaces at the end of each period.
- Teachers will prop doors for passing period.
- Hand sanitizer will be available in classrooms and throughout the building.
- Teachers/students will disinfect art supplies, lab materials, classrooms book sets, etc. after each use. Students will not share materials unless they have been sanitized between use.
- When able, students should provide their own materials.

Face Coverings

- Students, teachers, and staff will be required to wear face coverings that completely cover their mouth and nose. Any print or messages must be school appropriate.
- Individual face shields will be supplied for drama and choir students.
- The school will provide one mask for each student.
- The school will have extra masks for students that forget theirs.
- Mask breaks will be provided throughout the day.

Symptomatic/Sick Students At School

- Any student showing symptoms will be isolated in the sick room and parents will be asked to pick up the student.
- The room will be sanitized after each use.

Student Check-Out Procedures

- Parents should come to the office to check out students.
- Parents will need to socially distance and wear face coverings.

Assemblies, Performances, etc.

There will be no large gatherings until restrictions change; this includes assemblies, concerts, performances, etc.

Hallway

- Students will follow designated paths for hallway flow, staying to the right-hand side of the hallway in the direction that they are travelling.
- Face coverings will be worn during all passing times.

Altered School Schedule

Our early-out everyday schedule will give teachers opportunities for collaboration, reteaching, and professional development. School will begin at 7:55 AM and end at 1:50 PM. Please arrange for your students to have a way home from school.

Reteaching

Teachers will collaborate to create plans for reteaching/remediation to take place during their class periods, as well as with small groups and/or individuals after school.

Drinking Water

Students should bring refillable water bottles for drinking water throughout the day because the drinking fountains have been turned off. However, several bottle fillers have been installed throughout the building.

Lunchroom

- There will be 3 lunches this year in order to make room for social distancing in the lunchroom.
- Seats have been designated 6 ft. apart. Students may choose any seat that is available.
- Students may also eat in the commons area or on the blacktop on the NE side of the school.
- As always, we are a closed campus, so students may not walk off campus.
- Students may remove face coverings to eat, but should put them on as soon as they are done eating.
- If students are outside, they do not need to wear face coverings if practicing social distancing.
- Students are encouraged to go to NE side of the school and get some fresh air during lunch.

PE, Body Conditioning, Aerobic Conditioning

- Students can choose whether to dress or not.
- Students should wear athletic shoes and workout friendly clothing if they do not dress.
- Only 20 students will be allowed in the locker rooms at a time.

Guest Speakers/Visitors

- Guest speakers/visitors will be reviewed for symptoms and have their temperature checked before going into classrooms.
- They will wear appropriate face coverings and practice social distancing.
