

School Access Route Descriptions:

1. Students living near Hazel Drive are encouraged to make their way to Chrisman Drive, and then to Main Street. Main Street can be followed to Hwy 198, where students can use a crosswalk to cross 198 and continue north along the east side of Main Street until they reach the school.
2. Students living between 300 West, Salem Canal Road, 100 East (down to about 538 South and over to Apple Blossom Way), Towers Drive, and Mountain View Drive are encouraged to make their way to 300 West Mountain View Drive, and travel north on the east side of 300 West to Hwy 198. See the map for highlighted routes. At 198, students should stay on the south sidewalk and walk east to Main Street where they can cross 198 using a cross walk and continue north along the east side of Main Street until they reach the school.
3. Students living on the west side of 300 West, between 700 south, Salem Canal Road, and 700 West are encouraged to walk along 10300 South/800 South (county/city address) to 300 West, and then walk north on the west side of 300 West to the intersection at 300 W. 300 S. This intersection is controlled by four stop signs. At this intersection, students should cross to the east side of 300 West and continue north along the east side of 300 West to Hwy 198. At 198, students should stay on the south sidewalk and walk east to Main Street where they can cross 198 using a cross walk and continue north along the east side of Main Street until they reach the school.
4. Students living west of Mt. Loafer Elementary School and south of (above) Salem Canal Road are encouraged to walk east on the south side of Salem Canal Road to 100 East. This intersection is controlled by four stop signs. Students should cross to the north side of Salem Canal Road via the west side of this intersection, and then walk west along the north side of Salem Canal Road until they reach 40 East. At 40 East students should make their way to Apple Blossom Way and 225 West, and then walk north to Mountain View Drive and 300 West. At 300 West students should travel north, staying on the east side of the road until they reach Hwy 198. See the map for highlighted routes. At 198, students should stay on the south sidewalk and walk east to Main Street where they can cross 198 using a crosswalk and continue north along the east side of Main Street until they reach the school.
5. Students living south of (above) Salem Canal Road, between 191 West, 500 East, and the High Line Canal Road are encouraged to either:
6. Walk to 100 East Salem Canal Road and cross to the north side of Salem Canal Road via the west side of this intersection. Then walk west along the north side of Salem Canal Road until they reach 40 East. At 40 East, students should make their way to Apple Blossom Way and 225 West, and then walk north along 225 West to Mountain View Drive and 300 West. At 300 West, students should travel north, staying on the east side of the road until they reach Hwy 198. See the map for highlighted routes. At 198, students should stay on the south sidewalk and walk east to Main Street where they can cross 198 using a cross walk, and then continue north along the east side of Main Street until they reach the school.
7. Walk to 500 East and 620 South, and then cross to the east side of 5th East. This intersection is a three way stop and has a crosswalk leading to the east side of 5th East. From here, students can walk north to the Salem Canal Road on a sidewalk. The intersection at Salem Canal Road and 5th East is controlled by four stop signs. The intersection at Salem Canal Road and 450 E is controlled by four stop signs. Students should cross to the north side of Salem Canal Road via the east side of this intersection. Students should follow 450 E north to 300 S, then travel west to 300 East. They should then follow 300 East north to Center Street. Center Street should then be followed west to Main Street, and then students should travel north on the east side of Main Street until they reach Hwy 198. Using the crosswalk,

students should cross to the north side of 198 and continue north on the east side of Main Street until they reach the school.

8. Students living between Woodland Hills Road, Salem Canal Road, 500 East, and the High Line Canal Road are encouraged to make their way down through the neighborhoods to the intersection of 720 East Salem Canal Road. At this intersection, students should walk west along the south side of Salem Canal Road to 450 East. The intersection at Salem Canal Road and 450 E is controlled by four stop signs. Students should cross to the north side of Salem Canal Road via the east side of this intersection. Students should follow 450 E north to 300 S, then travel west to 300 East. They should then follow 300 East north to Center Street. Center Street should then be followed west to Main Street, and then students should travel north on the east side of Main Street until they reach Hwy 198. Using the crosswalk, students should cross to the north side of 198 and continue north on the east side of Main Street until they reach the school.
9. Students living adjacent to Veterans Memorial Park and students living east of 100 East 300 South, between Center Street, 100 East, 500 East, and Salem Canal Road are encouraged to walk to and follow the highlighted walk route identified on the map for this area. The intersection at 100 East and Center Street stops north and south bound traffic. Students living in this described area should cross 100 East at Center Street and keep walking west to Main Street. Walking north along the east side of Main Street to Hwy 198, students should cross to the north side of 198 via the crosswalk and continue north on the east side of Main Street until they reach the school.
10. Students living south of Hwy 198 and adjacent to Main Street are encouraged to follow Main Street north to Hwy 198. Using the cross walk, students should cross to the north side of 198 and continue north on the east side of Main Street until they reach the school.
11. Students living east of Main Street, between Hwy 198 and 400 North are discouraged from using 400 North as an access route to school. Students in this area are encouraged to walk to Hwy 198 and travel west to Main Street, and then continue north on the east side of Main Street until they reach the school.
12. Students living in the Sheen Acres area (north of Hwy 198 between 480 West and 300 West) are encouraged to walk to Hwy 198 and travel east along Hwy 198 to Main Street. Then walk north along the west side Main Street to the school. At the school, use the crosswalk to cross to the east side of Main Street.
13. Students living south of Hwy 198, between 200 West, 500 West, and 470 South are encouraged to walk to 300 West and then walk north to Hwy 198. Students in this area who live west of 300 West are encouraged to cross to the east side of 300 West at the 300 south intersection. This intersection is controlled by four stop signs. At 198, students should stay on the south sidewalk and walk east to Main Street where they can cross 198 using a cross walk, and then continue north along the east side of Main Street until they reach the school.
14. Students living north of 400 North and east of Hwy 198 are encouraged to walk along 400 North to the signaled intersection, cross to the west side of Hwy 198 via the north crosswalk, and then walk north along 198 to approximately 700 North (Stokes Grocery Store), and then walk west along the south side of 700 North until they reach the school.
15. Students living in the town homes East of the Junior High are encouraged to walk north on the sidewalk along Hwy 198 to Stokes Grocery Store (approx. 800 North). From here, students can access the school by following the road west.
16. Students living between 500 East, 400 North, Woodland Hills Rd, and 140 North are encouraged to walk to 180 North and 500 East. At 500 East, students should walk south on the east side of the road to 100 North and then cross to the west side of 500 East. Students should walk west along 100 North to 400 East and then walk north on the east side of 400 East until they reach 400 North. Staying on the south side of 400 North, students should walk to the signaled

intersection. At the signaled intersection, students should cross to the northeast side of the intersection via the crosswalk, and then cross to the northwest side of the intersection via the crosswalk. Proceed East along 400 North to Main Street. Turn right on Main Street and walk two blocks North until you reach the Junior High.

17. Students living adjacent to 500 East (on the west side of the road), between 100 North and 400 North are encouraged walk to 200 North, then west to 400 East, then north to 400 North. AND, Students living adjacent to 500 East (on the east side of the road) between 180 North and 400 North are encouraged to walk along the east side of 500 East to 400 North. At 400 North they should walk west on the south side of 400 North until they reach the signaled intersection. At the signaled intersection, students should cross to the northeast side of the intersection via the crosswalk, and then cross to the northwest side of the intersection via the crosswalk. Proceed East along 400 North to Main Street. Turn right on Main Street and walk two blocks North until you reach the Junior High.
18. Students living near 50 North, but east of 500 East are encouraged to walk to 50 North and 500 East. Then walk north on the east side of 500 East to 100 North where they should cross to the west side of 500 East. Students should walk west along 100 North to 400 East and then walk north on the east side of 400 East until they reach 400 North. Then they should walk west on the south side of 400 North until they reach the signaled intersection. At the signaled intersection, students should cross to the northeast side of the intersection via the crosswalk, and then cross to the northwest side of the intersection via the crosswalk. Proceed East along 400 North to Main Street. Turn right on Main Street and walk two blocks North until you reach the Junior High.
19. Students living west of Main Street and adjacent to 400 North and students living north of 400 North along Main Street should walk along the sidewalks and cross 400 North and/or Main Street at controlled intersections that have designated pedestrian crossing.
