


Any reasonable person wouldn't want to give it to them because it's their LAST piece, I know I wouldn't, but any reasonable person would also feel bad.

So who are you, going around and asking for gum and making people feel like they can't say no?


Just go to the store and buy your own gum. What's a dollar and twenty one cents? It's not that bad. Better safe than sorry because people these days are gooing to start saying no.

Screamatorium has real life animals in their set! The reviews says that it is very scary, but so much fun! It is located in Sunset, Utah.


Nightmare on 13th is a haunted house that you get locked in a room for 60 min with your group, and you try to find clues to get out before the 60 min is over.


The Nintendo Switch is a great item to get. Like any other, the Switch is a gaming console that allows you to play games on it. But unlike the others, the Switch has some amazing features.


Must-listen music


