


#### Salem Jr. Is a Standards-Based School!


The purpose of a standards-based grading system is to communicate to students and parents the proficiency level attained by the student for each individual standard found in each course.


valley view proficiency is a 4

#### SaJHS SBG Proficiency Rubric

	4	Student shows <b>master</b> understanding of the standard. There is <b>excess</b> evidence of understanding.
	3	Student shows <b>proficient</b> understanding of the the standard. There is <b>adequate</b> evidence of understanding.
	2	Student shows <b>basic</b> understanding of the standard but <b>lacks proficiency</b> in key areas. There is <b>some</b> evidence of understanding.
	1	Student shows <b>minimal</b> understanding of the standard. There is <b>little</b> evidence of understanding.
	0	Student shows <b>no</b> understanding of the standard. There is <b>no</b> evidence of understanding.
