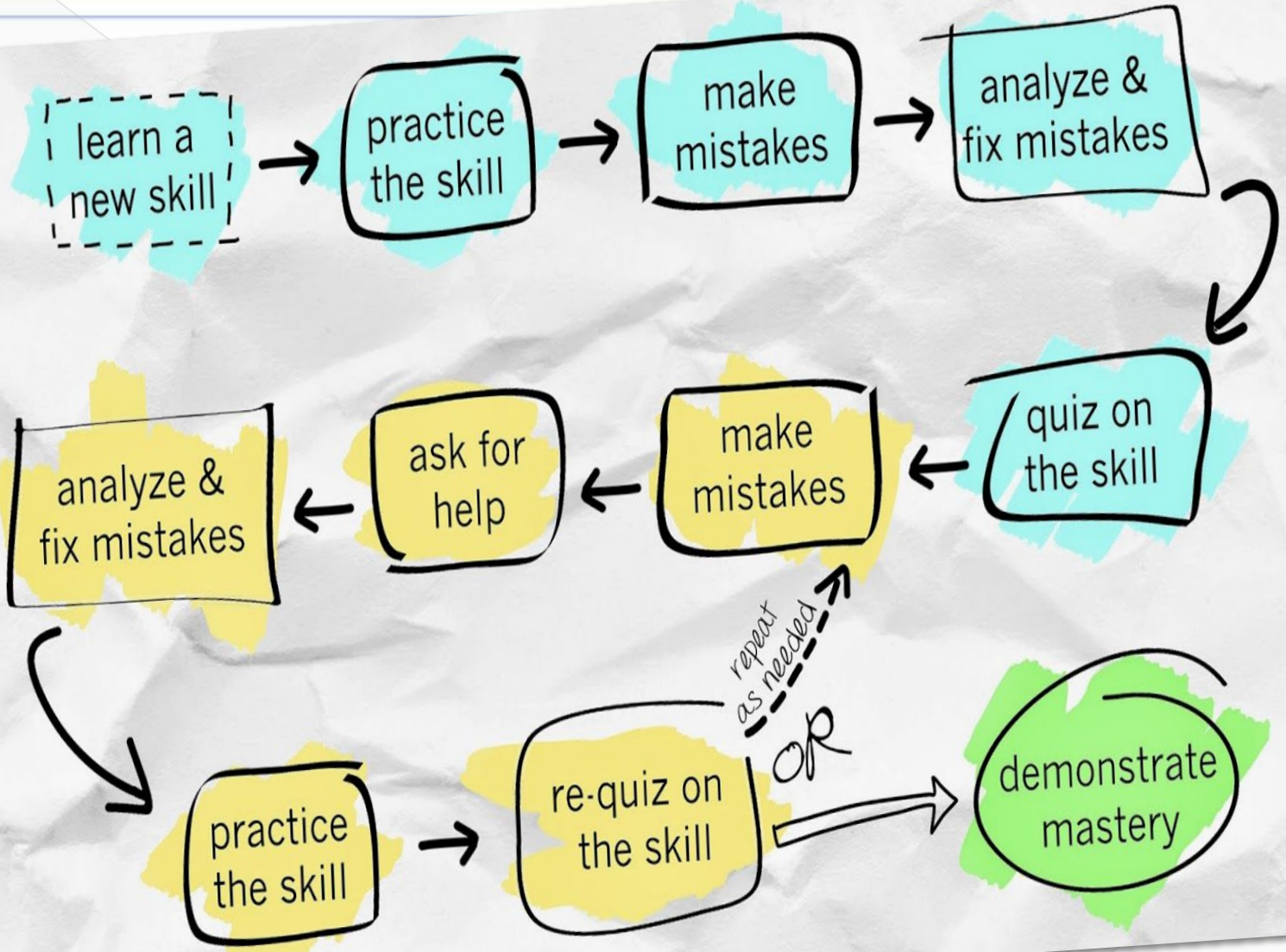
Salem Jr. Is a Standards-Based School!

The purpose of a standards-based grading system is to communicate to students and parents the proficiency level attained by the student for each individual standard found in each course.



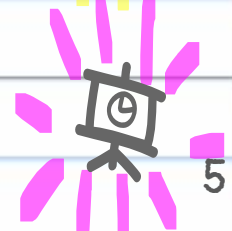
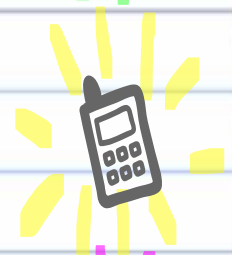
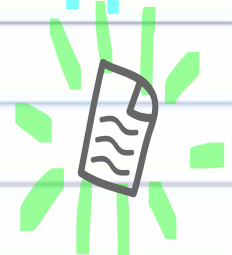


SBG Flow

- Teachers can share data and collaborate on teaching and assessing the standards.



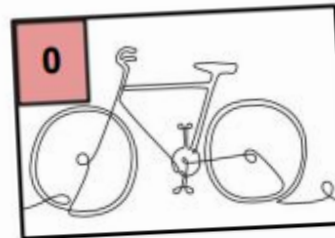
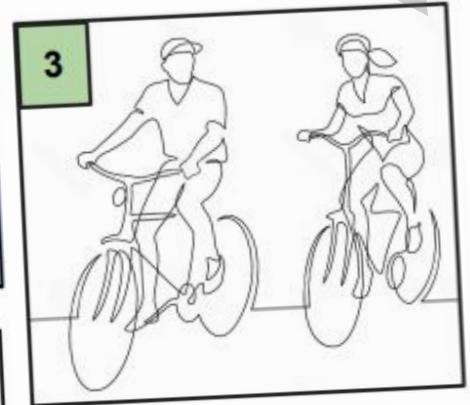
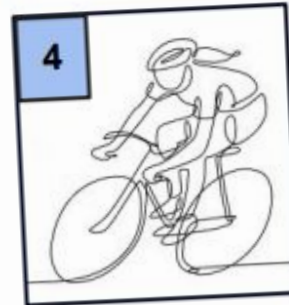

SaJHS SBG Proficiency Rubric

4	Student shows master understanding of the standard. There is excess evidence of understanding.
3	Student shows proficient understanding of the the standard. There is adequate evidence of understanding.
2	Student shows basic understanding of the standard but lacks proficiency in key areas. There is some evidence of understanding.
1	Student shows minimal understanding of the standard. There is little evidence of understanding.
0	Student shows no understanding of the standard. There is no evidence of understanding.
